This GORE-TEX PLUS WARM package features a fully waterproof, breathable insert paired with a grippy Pittards® leather palm seals out storms, while a merino wool-blend liner and breathable PrimaLoft® Gold 3-oz insulation keep hands warm on bitterly cold ridges. Fine-finger dexterity and tough goatskin leather palms toughen up grip for sharps, ropes or just hundreds of near-perfect pole plants.




On the coldest, deepest days, skiers and riders who know choose GORE-TEX mitts to ensure high-functioning fingers. To make it so, our storm barrier construction utilizes a fully waterproof combination. The construction features a fully waterproof package: GORE-TEX PLUS WARM technology, waterproof three-layer outer cuff, and the ultimate warmth of 3-oz PrimaLoft Gold insulation. Premium Pittards leather palms and fingers add secure grip and long season durability, while the wool separated finger liner maintains warmth. Adjustable gauntlet-style cuffs seal out the elements at any and all elevations.




Hard-charging skiers follow the line of pro patrollers, who trust insulated work gloves to outlast 150-day seasons. Our Hardscrabble taps into that gritty open-to-close ethic with durable Pittards® water-resistant leather and a tough, reverse texture palm. A combo of 3-oz PrimaLoft® Gold insulation and a wool lining warms up cold temps. The adjustable cuff closure seals out wind and snow, yet still slides easily over the watch that tracks your vertical, while the touchscreen-friendly leather index tip keeps you connected.




The Nordic tracks of Trail Creek Ranch are a local treasure in our valley. We designed our highly breathable glove to honor aerobic individuals who charge that venue at the base of Teton Pass. Made for winter disciplines from classic and skate to fatbike and weekend biathlon, the construction features a breathable, wind-resistant shell that cuts the chill and sheds the elements, while the Pittards* goatskin palm with a Teton emboss keeps a grip on carbon poles, bike handles or tools for other valley pastimes, like fly rods. A phone-friendly fingertip dials you into your fitness apps.



Wyoming winters get brutally cold, so insulated mitts are the local's favorite for keeping fingers functional on big powder days—or when waiting out long weekend lift lines. Premium PrimaLoft* 3-oz insulation preserves warmth while a merino wool-blend lining with individual finger dividers maximizes both heat and comfort. Water-repellent Pittards* leather sheds the elements while still letting hands breathe. Reversed texture palms grip poles securely and conductive leather on the index finger enables touchscreen use while keeping hands warm.



Skinning or bootpacking with ski gloves gets hot and sweaty. Our solution-focused Uptrack is profiled for the sole purpose of gaining vertical — whether for fitness or glory. Breathable, waterproof shell fabric finds that fine line between sweaty palms and frozen fingers during max output grinds. Pittards® goatskin palms provide good grip while breathable 3-oz PrimaLoft® insulation and an interior wool lining add just the right degree of warmth. Low-pro knit cuffs slide on or off easily when switching between skin and stash modes. A phone-friendly fingertip ensures gramability for the best pow shots.



Mountain life takes many winter forms which is why we built the fleece. Seeker with a combination of duality and utility. From shoveling out the truck or launching the driftboat to stashing along on a backpack trip or alpine scramble, the two-layered combo of Polartec[®] Power Stretch[®] Pro™ fleece, and Karuishi[®] smooth-surface knit provides light warmth and full functional dexterity. A silicone palm grips a wide range of gear or tools and a phone-friendly index fingertip keeps you connected, even when the goal is getting out there.
